The idea of talking about our faith and sharing it with others can cause strong reactions. Fear. Nerves. Excitement. Uncertainty. Let's face it, telling the Good News of the Gospel can be difficult for lots of reasons, even when our faith is at its strongest. Yet a faith worth having is a faith worth sharing! Thankfully, scripture not only tells us *to* share our faith, it also helps us learn *how*, for our own time and place.

### **Week 1: The Great Commission | Matthew 28:16-20**

Amidst our own experiences with evangelism and the many doubts that we carry, Christ inspires and calls us to a life of faith-sharing with the assurance that when we go, he goes with us.

### **Week 2: The Good News is for Everyone | Acts 10:30-48**

The unstoppable power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ breaks down barriers, so that all might know the transformative love of God.

### **Week 3: Meet People Where They Are | Acts 17:16-28**

Paul shows us that sharing often starts with learning and listening. Understanding each other can be the basis for sharing and hearing of the Gospel.

### **Week 4: The World Needs the Good News | John 3:11-20**

God loves each of us just the way we are. Through Christ, we are forgiven and offered life and salvation. What a gift that we get share this Good News with others!

### **Week 5: Tell Somebody with A Life of Love | Luke 6:32-38**
